CHECKLIST FOR ITALIAN PASSPORT APPLICATION/RENEWAL BY ADULT APPLICANTS:

- 1. Old Italian passport (original + copy of the picture page only);
- 2. AZ driver's license (original + photocopy). NOTE: the address on your driver's license MUST match the address on file with the Consulate. You can check your own consular file here: https://serviziconsolari.esteri.it/ScoFE/index.sco#
- **3.** Recent utility bill in your name (the address must march the one on file with the Consulate in LA as well as on your AZ driver's license)
- **4.** Italian passport application form completed, <u>to be signed and dated before the Honorary</u> Consul of Arizona;
- 5. Money order or cashier's check of \$124.40 payable to the "Consulate General of Italy Los Angeles" [note: this amount is valid only from **April 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023**];
- **6.** 2 passport-size pictures;
- 7. If you were born in the U.S.A.: photocopy of your US passport;
- **8.** If you were born outside of the USA:
 - **8.a** If you live in the USA as a legal resident: US Visa or Green Card issued after August 16th, 1992. If these documents cannot be provided you will need to provide a US Immigration declaration confirming you never became an American Citizen or show the US entry stamp on the passport. Without the above NO PASSPORT will be issued;
 - **8.b** If you live in the USA as a US citizen: copy of your naturalization certificate [or Consular Report of Birth Abroad] + copy of your US passport;
- **9.** If you (the applicant) have minor children: bring a copy of the minor's birth certificate + the "Atto di assenso/Authorization form" signed by the other parent. **Note:**
 - **9.a** If other parent is a citizen of Italy or of the European Union: the consent form signed by the other parent must include a photocopy of his/her Italian or E.U. passport (page with passport holder's information AND signature).
 - **9.b** If other parent is NOT a citizen of Italy of the European Union: the signature of the other parent on the consent form must be authenticated by a notary public and must include a copy of the other parent's passport.
 - **9.c** If other parent is deceased: provide a photocopy of the death certificate.
 - **Please note:** The parental consent is ALWAYS necessary even if the applicant is the parent, and not the minor. The "atto di assenso" form must be typewritten [no handwriting] and must be provided regardless of whether you and the other parent were never married/are now separated/divorced. The consent cannot be older than 6 months and it must bear a wet signature [no printed PDF sent by email]. The other parent will need to complete and sign also the bottom portion of your Italian passport application (same as above: notarization + copy of passport attached for non EU citizens).
- 10. 2 pre-paid USPS Priority Express envelopes (flat rate of \$28.75 each way, for a total of \$57.50): one from you to the Consulate in Los Angeles [Consulate General of Italy, Passport Department, 1900 Avenue of the Stars, Suite # 1250, Los Angeles, CA 90067-4404]; one where your address appears on the sender's as well as the recipient's box [example: from Roberta Gentili, 1 Befana Way Phoenix, AZ 85001; to: Roberta Gentili, 1 Befana Way Phoenix, AZ 85001];
- 11. Authorization to ship back to you your new and old Italian passports by mail.
